Everyone can help to shape the KNL. Therefore, the visitors can and should bring useful things to the shop and help with cleaning and tidying up in order to contribute according to their own capability.

The KNL is self-administered, the rent is financed by donations. **Giving, taking and sharing are the basis of this concept.**

The KNL does not accept the following items:

- defective technical equipment
- dirty or broken textiles
- Underwear of all kinds, chamber pots or toilet inserts
- Food
- Drugs, cosmetics or drugstore products
- tobacco, alcohol or drugs
- Toxic chemicals, flammable and explosive substances or special-waste
- New or old batteries
- large kitchen knives, weapons or toys that encourage war
- Publicity for the State, political parties or sects
- Out dated technical literature or newspapers
- Burned data carriers of all kind (DVDs, CDs, etc.)
